# Highlights of Paul's

## Departure November 4th

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA.

## Arrive in Rome, Italy November 5th

Arrive in Rome, Italy and embark on the *Celebrity Equinox*.

## At Sea November 6th

## Santorini, Greece November 7th

Visit the spectacular circular archipelago formed by a volcanic explosion that destroyed this center of Minoan civilization 3,600 years ago, which some sources identify as the lost city of Atlantis. (Excursions/Lunch on own.)

## At Sea November 8th

## Istanbul, Turkey November 9th & 10th

The bejeweled capital of **Istanbul** sits between two continents and is home to 450 mosques. You will visit the famous **Blue Mosque** with its six minarets and sparkling interior. You will also visit the **Topkapi Palace**, once home to royal Sultans. Inside, you will see the fabled jewels of the Treasury, delicate displays of Chinese porcelain in the Kitchen Quarters, and the provocative Harem Quarters.



Walk through **St. Sophia (Hagia Sophia)**, which was the largest church in Christendom for 1000 years. Built by Justinian (532-537 A.D.), the church has 107 columns; fossil imbedded white marble floors, and beautiful glass mosaics. Today, it is the Museum of Byzantine Art. On your second day in Istanbul you will enjoy the aroma of cinnamon, cloves, thyme, and other exotic spices as you explore the **Grand Bazaar**. Over 4000 shops sell everything from herbs to gold. Make your way to the renowned **Spice Market**. (Lunch on Own.)

## Ephesus, Turkey November 11th

Journey to **Ephesus**, the marble city where Paul spent three years of his ministry. It was to this community that Paul may have written his Epistle to the Ephesians. The ruins of Ephesus have been restored much like the city was in Paul's time. You will visit the ancient **Agora** and imagine where Demetrius, the silversmith, sold his silver shrines of the Greek goddess Artemis. You will view the **Great Theater** and see the place where Paul witnessed faithfully for Christ. (Lunch Included.)

## Athens & Corinth, Greece November 12th

The architectural splendors of the ancient city of **Athens** are as magical as ever. Follow your guide on a journey to the ancient **Acropolis** where you will see the **Propylaea**, the **Parthenon** and the **Erectheum**. View **Mars Hill** where Paul preached the gospel to the intellectual Athenian community of his day (Acts 17: 15-34). You will view the **Olympic Stadium**, where the modern Olympics began. Travel to Corinth (Acts 18: 1-18), a city that inspired St. Paul's most familiar letter. You will visit the **Archaeological Museum, the Market Place, and Temples**. Walk among the ruins and stand on the Bema where Paul stood. Read Paul's letter to the Corinthians and visualize his address to the Gentiles as he began the task of building Corinth's church. (Lunch on Own.)

History is woven through the streets and neighborhoods of **Rome** as in no other city. Today you'll explore the many wonders of ancient Rome when you visit the magnificent **Colosseum**.
