



United Methodist Men's 100 Club Annual Giving Letter



Here is for almost the twenty-third year we have been in existence. Twenty-three years ago come January 1, 2012 we had a vision of helping young men and women further their education by offering scholarship funds. We have for the past ten years been doing exactly that. We started with nothing, not even a special gift. We now have over sixteen hundred donors and for that we are grateful.

We only spend the interest earned on our investment plus the revenue generated from the auction for scholarship dollars. We established an Endowment Fund so that this mission will go on forever. Our funds are invested and we have kept a tight rein as we only give to those that qualify. We currently have a market value of eighty-five thousand dollars in our endowment.

In order to grow and give more, we need to nurture some much larger gifts and that is one of the purposes of this letter.

Just for example, if you would consider leaving a legacy gift of two to five percent in your will, and of course more if you are so moved to do so, it would help insure our mission will grow and remain much stronger.

I know that some of you farm and farming has been good for many people these last few years with record-setting commodity prices and farmland reaching record-setting highs. If someone would leave the United Methodist Men an eighty or a quarter we could launch our efforts into a full time Ministry where we could really make a difference.

This letter will go to some two thousand people and that in itself takes money.

We are asking that this year you consider supporting our mission with a gift of ten or twenty dollars for our administrative fund and additional gift to our ministry fund.

I'm sure you know someone in your church or family who would be surprised to be honored with a membership into the United Methodist Men's One Hundred Club. It's only one "Ben Franklin" to get this accomplished.

If you really want to honor someone donate a thousand dollars and we will recognize them in your church with a One Thousand Club plaque that we are sure will get their attention. We currently have one hundred and seven United Methodist men and women who are members of the One Thousand Club.
